FOSTER SUPPORT PROGRAM

Here are just two methods which may work for your church:

Events

Hosting events is just one way to open your church to the community and let people know that you care about foster families. Events are varied and limited only by your imagination: a winter carnival for kids, a babysitting evening to give foster parents a date night, or providing a meeting space for a support group.

Care teams

Care teams are members from your congregation who work together to support foster families. A team lead acts as the point of contact for the foster parents and coordinates their team to meet the family's needs. Teams can be as small as 2-3 volunteers or as large as 6-8, and a single church can have many teams. Care teams receive access to our educational enrichment resources and ongoing support.
