

## Project Manager's Letter- Camp Phillip, Wautoma, WI

Builders For Christ will be assisting Camp Phillip near Wautoma, WI with exterior insulation, siding, soffit and fascia on their existing Camp Director's house. Wautoma is located in Central Wisconsin.

The camp was established in 1968. The current building was built in 1980 and is located near the main camp entrance at W9944 Buttercup Ave, Wautoma, Wisconsin 54982.

Camp Phillip serves youth year-round with over 1100 program nights.

Builders For Christ will be installing a new exterior shell on the house. It will be furring strips and ridged insulation on the basement, Vinyl siding on all walls, and aluminum soffit & fascia. This will cover the existing T-111 siding on the upper floor and bare cinder block on the basement

The project is scheduled for 3-4 weeks. We will have onsite camping for 10 campers and there will also be cabin space for those without an RV. The work week will be Tuesday through Saturday.

The three main phases of work are:

Phase # 1 – Furring, insulation, sheathing exposed basement. September 7-11

Phase # 2 - soffit, fascia; Roofline and between floors. September 7-19

Phase # 3 – House wrap and siding. September 13-25
